

Crimson Point PTA INVITES you to the Summer Reading Program 2008

WHO: Every student at Crimson Point will be given a list of Children's Choice books within their reading level which are available from the Kuna Community Library. In addition, we have chosen websites where students can find book lists within their reading level and interest category. There will also be two hard copies of the HAISLN recommended reading list available for reference at the Kuna Library for those not having access to internet.

WHAT: 1. Students going into grades K-2 are asked to read 9 recommended books and students grades 3 and up are asked to read 5 recommended chapter books through out the summer within their reading level or higher. Two of these books can be audio books (CD, Tape, read to by parent, etc...)
2. Complete one book report. When the students return to school, they will be asked to give a book report during their library time on the favorite book they read this summer. This can be as fun and creative as they would like—make their own cereal box starring the book, act out a scene from the book, prepare a diorama, write a commercial...the possibilities are only limited by their creativity.

WHEN: Start as soon as you want!

WHERE: Encourage your student to read all summer long! One event we recommend is to participate in the Kuna Library Summer Reading program www.kunalibrary.org The CPPTA summer reading program is designed to compliment the great service the Kuna Library provides.

WHY: It is our goal to: 1. Provide parents with a list of skill-appropriate books to challenge their children throughout the summer, 2. To encourage students to read all summer long, and 3. To help prevent loss of reading skills.

PRIZE: Every student who completes the summer reading log and presents a book report of their choosing will be able to be LIBRARIAN for their class for the day. Mrs. Stringer, the Crimson Point Librarian, has agreed to let every child who completes the program be her special helper.

Thank you for your willingness to help your child succeed in this program. Also, special thanks go to the staff and teachers at Crimson Point for helping to make this program a success.
